For people who cannot afford health insurance and do not qualify for government health programs such as: Medicare and Medical Assistance.

Most services at the clinic are free. If patients are referred out to a doctor, dentist, or hospital etc., the normal cost of these services is reduced based on the patients' ability to pay with a minimum of 25%.

Patients are accepted on a first come-first serve walk-in basis unless they have an appointment with a specialist.

Affordable Care Act/Marketplace

If you do not have coverage the marketplace may help you find and enroll in a plan. Most people who apply qualify for premium tax credits that lower the cost of coverage.

BadgerCare Plus/Medicaid

Is a healthcare program for low income residents. BadgerCare Plus/Medicaid is for adults, children and pregnant women. Express enrollment is also available for children who are under 19 years old and pregnant women.

Family Planning is for men & women between the ages of 15-44 years old. Express enrollment is also available.

FoodShare helps individuals with limited income purchase food.

Includes diagnostic tests related to breast cancer, cervical cancer and osteoporosis.

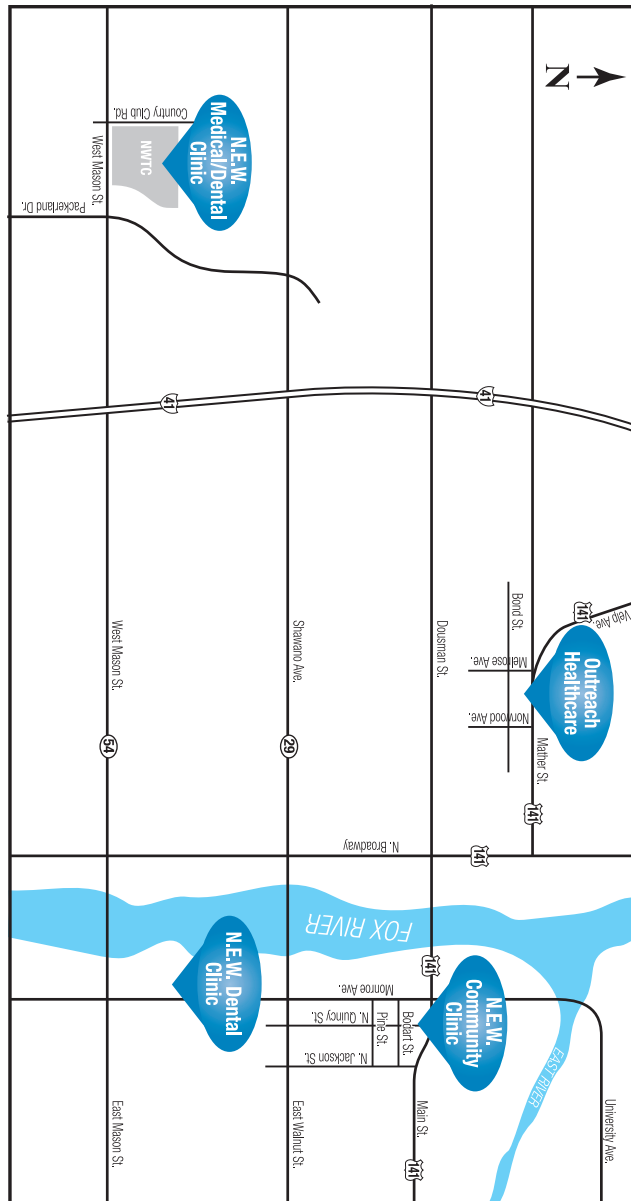
